## Billing Guidelines

The Healix Schedule of Fees is based on the CCSD coding system and has been adapted by Healix Health Services.

This Schedule of Fees lists what Healix considers to be reasonable and customary fees for the procedures listed. The fee levels have been set after review of what the majority of specialists' bill for medical services provided as well as a review by the Healix Chief Medical Officer and our panel of specialist advisors.

The maximum amount payable for a procedure includes all pre-operative, intra-operative and post-operative care associated with in-patient or day-case by the surgeon and/or anaesthetist.

It also includes the management of all common complications related to the condition such as:

1. Bleeding
2. Intravenous fluids
3. Suction
4. Catheterization
5. Uncomplicated sepsis
6. Removal of sutures
7. Intra-operative administration of local anaesthesia by the operating specialist even when a General Anaesthetic has been used
8. Surgical Assistant fees – this means there will be no additional fees paid for surgical assistants involved in any procedure
9. Intensive care – for procedures that routinely include this is as part of post-operative care
10. Management of post-operative analgesia
11. Follow-up outpatient consultations within seven days of the surgical procedure
12. Management of minor complications during the peri-operative period.

## Coding Principles (Unbundling)

All CCSD schedule users should use a single CCSD code to describe the majority of common clinical interventions. This single code fully describes the procedure from start to finish. The code covers the actual operation itself and all component parts and additional procedures, which are routinely or commonly performed with the operation.

For example:

- Pre-operative assessment
- Anaesthesia
- Intra-operative care
- Post-operative care
- Intensive care
- Wound dressing and care
- Immediate post operative analgesia (e.g. nerve blocks, local anaesthetic infiltrations, local anaesthesia to joint spaces).

No common clinical intervention should routinely require more than one code but occasionally, two procedures undertaken at the same time may legitimately require two codes to fully describe them.

In the event that more than two codes are needed to describe a procedure, a new code request should be made to CCSD online at [www.ccsd.co.uk](http://www.ccsd.co.uk) so that an additional single code may be issued.

## Multiple procedure rules

Where two procedures are performed at the same time we will pay as follows:

- Full benefit for the highest rated procedure
- 50% of the fee for the second highest rated procedure
- Fees for a third or more procedures will only be considered under exceptional circumstances and all requests must be forwarded to [managedcare@healix.com](mailto:managedcare@healix.com).

## Bilateral Procedures

Some procedures are performed bilaterally and are referred to in the Schedule of Fees as "... and bilateral".

The maximum fees set out in this schedule take this into account and therefore no additional fees will be payable.

## Anaesthetic Fees

The same anaesthetic category will apply irrespective of whether general or regional anaesthetic has been administered and the fees include the following:

- Routine pre-operative assessment by the anaesthetist
- Induction, maintenance of anaesthesia and all support activities, both intra and post-operative
- Pain control throughout the hospital stay
- Post-operative care including up to 72 hours Intensive Therapy.

Where local anaesthesia and / or IV sedation has been administered by the specialist carrying out the procedure the multiple procedure policy will apply and the procedure code AC100 (Local Anaesthesia / IV sedation) should be used for billing purposes.

Epidural in addition to general anaesthesia or within 24 hours either side of the operation, the multiple procedure policy will apply.

## Consultation Charges

All out-patient consultations billed for must be face-to-face consultation only.

Only a single consultation may be claimed on any one day and cannot be on the same day as a surgical procedure.

In-patient care charges can only be billed by the physician in charge of the case and cannot be billed for the same day as a surgical procedure.

Other specialists requested to review the member on request of the controlling physician may claim benefit for specific consultations for specific problems only.

Out-patient follow-up within seven days of discharge are included in the surgical fees and considered to be an integral part of post-operative care and thus would not be reimbursed as an extra service.

However exception may be made for certain procedures where follow-up consultations fees and procedure charges may both be eligible on the same day.

## General rules

- Where a consultant assists another consultant, we will only pay the fee of the primary consultant
- Where two different procedures are performed on the same day but not in the same operating session, both procedures will be paid for at up to 100% of the eligible maximum
- Unbundled procedures will not be considered for payment in any circumstances.

## Good clinical practice

We expect all practitioners to follow requirements and guidelines relevant to your practice including:

- Good practice guidelines of your registering body, e.g. GMC, GDC, HPC
- Good practice guidelines of your specialty organisation or Royal College
- National Minimum Standards for Private and Voluntary Healthcare.

## Sending Invoices to Healix

Invoices for eligible treatment can be submitted to Healix electronically via Healthcode or by post. To avoid any processing delays please ensure that full details of the treatment delivered are provided.

Under the rules of our members' policies, all eligible claims must be submitted within six months of the date of treatment.

## Payments by Healix

Payments for all approved invoices will be made weekly either by BACS or cheque. This will be accompanied by a remittance advice which provides a breakdown of the total amount paid, the members it relates to and any shortfalls in payment made such as shortfalls due to a policy excess or other deductions.

As our members can access our team of nurse case managers at anytime between the hours of 9am – 5pm Monday to Friday they can easily find out any details of their claims and any payments made.

## Medically necessary and appropriate medical treatment

Our members' schemes do not provide benefit for experimental or unproven procedures, including those using new technology or drugs, where safety and effectiveness have not been established or generally not standard medical practice.

## Fraud and misrepresentation

The Fraud Act 2006 sets out the legal definition of fraud and creates offences of fraud by false misrepresentation, fraud by omission and fraud by abuse of position.

The law includes false statement made to any device capable of receiving information. Home Office guidance on the application of the Act states that it is intended to cover false statements made to insurance companies at underwriting.

Therefore we monitor claims and routinely audit claims received by reviewing medical records submitted as part of claims assessment. A person who makes a false statement, omits material facts or misuses a position of trust with the intention of causing loss to a third party is guilty of fraud even if he or she does not personally gain and even if the deception fails.

Healix considers the following to be fraud:

1. Up coding – billing a procedure of higher complexity than the one that was performed
2. Unbundling – additionally billing for component parts of a complex procedure
3. Billing for services that were not provided
4. Billing for services that were not medically necessary
5. Altering dates, description of services or medical records to secure payment
6. Misrepresentation of diagnoses or procedures to maximise payment
7. Omission of material facts.

Healix act in good faith and on the basis of the information that providers (including hospitals, clinicians and specialists) and our members give us. Any cases of suspected fraud or misrepresentation by healthcare providers or member identified by Healix will be investigated fully and referred to the General Medical Council, police or appropriate authority.

As part of Healix's anti-fraud measures we work with the NHS Counter-Fraud Team, Health Insurers Counter Fraud Group, Health Professionals' Trade Associations and other agencies. Healix reserve the right to withdraw our recognition of providers who have submitted fraudulent invoices or misrepresented the circumstances of a claim so as to obtain or facilitate benefit that would not otherwise be eligible under the terms of our member's policy.
